

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


APPENDIX C. G.L.S²⁺ RESULTS IN HIGH-ENROLLMENT ONLINE COURSE (C2; FALL 2016)




APPENDIX D. G.L.S²⁺ RESULTS IN HIGH-ENROLLMENT ONLINE COURSE (C2; SPRING 17)
