Request for Reuse of Published Material

The Center for Engaged Learning publishes work in the Open Access Book series under a [Creative Commons Attribution-NonCommercial-NoDerivatives 4.0 International license](#), the most restrictive of CC licenses. This means that you are free to:

- **Share** the material (copy, distribute, and display it) as long as it's for non-commercial purposes only (i.e., no monetary compensation involved).
- You **cannot change, remix, or adapt** the material in any way. It must be used exactly as it appears.
- You must provide proper **attribution** to the original author(s) and publisher.

Any other use requires permission from the publisher, the Center for Engaged Learning, who may also consult with the work's authors/editors.

In order to obtain documented permissions for reuse of material originally published in the Center for Engaged Learning's Open Access Book Series, please:

1. Fill out the attached form for each published work from which you are requesting reuse of material. Complete every field except for those in the gray box on page 3.
2. Send this document and a draft of the proposed reuse (e.g., a draft of the article or chapter that reuses the requested material) to the Center for Engaged Learning (the copyright holder) via email at **cel-publishing@elon.edu**.
3. CEL staff (the copyright holder) will complete the fields in the gray box, and send the completed document back to you. Keep a copy for your records.
